11th annual Memorial Day Baseball Bash Tournament - May 26-28, 2012

- To Enter:** Go to www.lvbaseballacademy.com and click on the tournament link. Scroll down the page to the downloadable forms.
- Tournament Fees:** \$695.00 + a \$30 CABA registration fee or \$725.00. Make check out to the Las Vegas Baseball Academy. Fees paid after April 15 is \$795.00 + a \$30 CABA registration fee or \$825.00.
A deposit of \$200 must be received at the time of registration.
- Age Divisions:** 8u, 9u, 10u, 11u, 12u, 13u, 14u.
- Age Qualification:** April 30, 2012.
- Tournament Deadline:** **April 15, 2012.** If fees/required paperwork are received after this date, teams will be assessed a \$100 late fee.

- Coaches:**
a) 3 coaches will be allowed in the dugout at all times. No trainers are allowed in the dugout.
b) Coaches may wear a full uniform or mesh type shorts. No jeans or cut-offs will be allowed on the field by any coach at any time. Flip flops, sandals or any other opened toed shoe will not be allowed on the playing field by any coach at anytime.
- All Players:** Must have a number on the back of his/her jersey.
- Birth Certificates:**
a) The team manager must bring copies of birth certificates to all games.
b) Rosters and birth certificates will be checked before each team's first game.
- Arrival:** Teams **must** arrive by **Friday** evening for possible early play on Saturday.
- Games:** **All teams will play 4 games.** Two games will be played on Saturday and Sunday by all teams. (NO EXCEPTIONS.)
- Forfeits:** If for any reason a team, in the opinion of the home plate umpire, is not playing the game to their ability that team will automatically forfeit their game, and will not be allowed to advance in the tournament. Also, if for any reason a team forfeits any tournament game, that team will not be allowed to advance in the tournament.
- Champion Games:**
a) No time limit for any games played on Monday.
b) Teams can call 702-401-5193 to find out if they advance to Monday's championship play **1 hour after** the final scheduled game on Sunday night.
- Arrival:** Plan to arrive one hour before all scheduled games. 1/2 before game time managers need to find an onsite LVBA official to flip for home team. A coin flip will take place in all pool/championship games.
- Infield:** There will be **NO** pre-game infield. (Note:) **DO NOT** take soft toss into any field fencing.
- Weather:** In case of rain there will be a voice-recorded message on the following phone number 702-256-7084.
- Cancellation/Refunds:** There are no refunds for cancellation within 45 days prior to the tournament for any reason. Cancellation 45 days prior to the tournament will receive a full refund less a \$100.00 handling fee.
- Rainout Policy:** 50% refunded if no games are played, 25% refund if 1 game is started, no refunds once 2nd game begins.
- Roster Rules:** Players may play on more than 1 team **except** for another team in the same age division. If a player is found to be playing on (2) different teams in the same age division both teams in violation will forfeit all games that that player participated in.
- Noise Makers:** NOT ALLOWED.
- LVBA:** Reserves the right to make any modifications to these rules for the improvement of the tournament.

Official Tournament Rules

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- Bat Rules:** **15u - 18u - BBCOR Bats** will be required for use in 2012 Tournament play. This change is to coincide with the High School bat requirements.
- 8u - 14u** - All youth bats must meet the 1.15 BPF - (Bat Performance Factor) or and stamped as such.
- Bats/Spikes:**
- a) Big barrel bats are allowed in all age divisions.
 - b) Metal spikes are **ALLOWED** in age divisions **12 and older**.
 - c) Metal spikes are **NOT** allowed for age's **8u - 11u**.
- Bases/Pitching Distances/Innings/ Time Limits**
- ***8u** = 60' Bases & 40' pitching, 6 innings, no new inning after 1:30 - ***MORE 8u RULES ARE ON THE LAST PAGE**
9u/10u = 65' bases & 46' pitching, 6 innings, no new inning will begin after 1:45.
11u/12u = 70' bases & 50' pitching, 6 innings, no new inning will begin after 1:45.
13u = 80' bases & 54' pitching, 7 innings, no new inning will begin after 2:00.
14u = 90' bases & 60'6" pitching, 7 innings, no new inning will begin after 2:00.
- Game Start Time:** It is the coach's responsibility to get the game start time from the umpire.
- Time Limits:** If games end in a tie, they may be played out until time limitations occur.
- Run Rules:**
- 6 inning games - 15 after 3 innings, 8 after 4 innings. (Championship games included.)
7 inning games - 15 after 3 innings, 12 after 4 innings and 8 after 5 innings. (Championship games included.)
- Offensive Lineups**
- Teams may bat 9 players, 10 players or their entire line-up. However, for teams electing to bat their entire line up, if a player leaves the game for any reason i.e. sickness, injury or ejection etc. when his turn comes to hit in the order he will be declared automatically out every time. If you are using 10 or more hitters list as EH on the line-up card
- Defensive Substitutions:** A player must be in the offensive line-up to play defense.
- Re-Entry:** Starter may enter one time to the same spot in the batting order.
- Base Runners/ Sliding:** Must slide or avoid when the defensive player has the ball or is ready to make a play. Failure to do so, in the umpires' determination could result in an ejection from the game. **No sliding headfirst into home plate. If a player slides headfirst into home plate, he will be declared automatically out.**
- Speed up Rule:** A courtesy runner will be allowed for the pitcher or catcher at anytime. Teams hitting the entire line-up must use the last recorded out.
- Offensive Changes:** Must be reported to the home plate umpire.
- Meetings:** Eliminate all team meetings before going out to play defense. This will be enforced.
- Ejections:** Any manager, coach or fan ejected must leave the park immediately or his team will forfeit the game..
NOTE: All ejections involving coaches and players will be reviewed by LVBA officials. After reviewing a determination will be made regarding continued tournament involvement for any coach/player. Any player ejected must sit out the next scheduled game. If the same player is ejected for a second time, he will not be allowed to participate for the remainder of the tournament. Failure to comply will result in forfeiture of the game.
- Pitching Rules:**
- a) Once a pitcher is removed from the game, he may not re-enter that game as a pitcher.
 - b) Coaches must remove the pitcher upon his 2nd trip to the mound in the same inning.
 - c) Use good judgment.
 - d) **No warning** on balks for all age divisions. There will be leniency in the 8u & 9u divisions.
- Tie Breakers:** Best Record, Head to Head, Fewest Runs Allowed, and Coin Flip.
- Suspended - Completed Games**
- A game shall be ruled as official and complete if it is called by the umpires or tournament director due to rain, inclement weather, lighting failure or other reasons beyond our control, provided 4 or more complete innings have been played. If 4 innings have not been completed, the game shall be suspended, and resumed from that point, when safe play can be resumed. If a game is ruled a complete game but the next full inning has not been completed, the final score will revert back to the end of the last completed inning.
- Rain Rule:** 4 innings or 1 hour constitutes a complete game when delayed or called because of inclement weather.

Tournament Rules - 8U Division

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Defensive Players: Nine (9) players shall play the field.

Batters: Bunting is allowed.
To intentionally walk a batter, a coach just needs to inform the umpire before the pitch is thrown to the batter.

Runners: Stealing is allowed once the ball crosses the plate.

No lead-offs. Players cannot leave base until after the ball crosses home plate. If a player leaves early and is thrown out, they are out. If they are safe: 1st offense, they must return to previous base: 2nd offense in the same inning they are out. If the ball is hit, the defensive team has the option of the result of the play or dead ball and runner returns and hitter hits again. Once the ball is thrown back to the pitcher by the catcher or any fielder at the conclusion of a play, at the umpire judgment, all base runners must return to their previous base if they are not at least halfway to next base.

Stealing home is not allowed. Runners may only score on a hit or when forced to score by a walk, HBP, or award from the umpire.

Runners shall not advance from third base to home on passed balls, wild pitchers or dropped/missed third strikes by the catcher.
